Open rings will be conducted under EFA Rules and Regulations, PCAV rules apply to the Pony Club Ring . Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that EFA, VASA and PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

All Competitors are required to fill in the Liability Declaration Form.

The organising committee reserves the right to cancel, divide alter or refuse entry to any class with or without stating the reason.

**No waiting in the rings – there are three open rings**  
**No refunds on unused tickets. Please do not request our classes to be modified. No dogs permitted.**

**Novice Horse /Galloway/ Pony—**While competing singularly has never been placed 1st in a similar class at any Agricultural Show or Gymkhana.

Novice winners are eligible for their relevant height championship.

**Show Hunters** are quality animals showing a little more substance and boldness of movement than is required for show horses. Show Hunter attire plain browbands, no ribbons, Hunter Jackets. Show Hunters are not eligible to compete in open ridden classes. Once a ridden horse or rider has won a Champion in a ring he/she are not eligible to compete in height or age class in another ring.

Neither the organizing committee or any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club Association of Victoria Inc. accepts any Liability for any accident damage injury or illness to horse, owners, riders, grounds, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.

Height certificates must be produced if requested.

### Good Hands Challenge Trophy

Rules and Regulations – local show

1. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is conducted at the VAS Saddle Horse Championships
2. The VAS Good Hands Challenge Trophy is open to boys and girls aged 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the local show/field day
3. All VAS affiliated shows/field days are invited to hold qualifying competitions. Show societies are encouraged to run one class at the local show which includes girls and boys
4. Good Hands certificates are available from the VAS office for presentation to the winner at a local show
5. The competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability - mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account
6. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony
7. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre. The mouthpiece must be smooth and made of the same type of metal, with or without a cavesson on the noseband
8. A gear check may take place
9. **Please note: straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs are not allowed.**

Supreme Champion Rider to receive an inscribed rug sponsored by WB Hunter and garland sponsored by HS Garlands. To be judged at the completion of all rings. All riders receiving a Champion Rider from 1, 2 and 3 are eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Rider which will be judged by the three respective judges.

Upon completion of the judging of the Supreme Champion Rider all horses receiving a Champion Ridden Pony, Galloway and Hack in both Open and Hunter from Rings 1, 2 and 3 are eligible to ride for Supreme Ridden Exhibit which will be judged by the three respective judges. 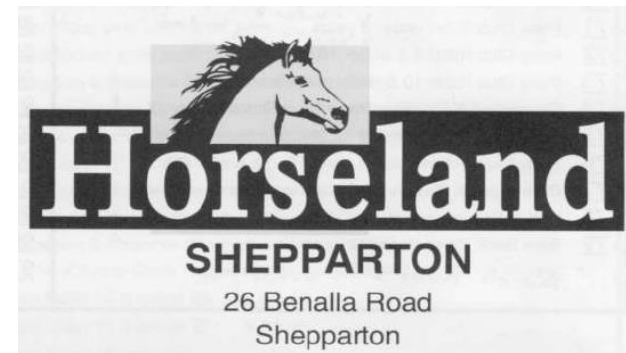

Special Horseland aggregate trophy for combination with highest points scored on the day. If competing with multiple horses, only point for one horse will be taken into account. The horse to accrue aggregate points must be notified to the administration office at the commencement of the day. (Trophy to remain at Horseland, winner to receive replica.)

Points awarded 1st = 4, 2nd = 3, 3rd = 2 4th = 1. All classes from Ring 4 count toward the aggregate trophy.
