EXPLANATION OF TERMINOLOGIES

SECTION is the Major heading i.e. Cookery, Needlework, etc which is given a number and under which you will find the various categories.

CLASS is the number under the Section which describes your exhibit.

COMPLETE BOTH SIDES OF YOUR ENTRY FORM (one of which is returned with your exhibit tickets).

EXHIBIT NUMBER on the exhibit ticket is the number given to your exhibit for Judging (names are not used).

NOVICE is a person hasn't won a first prize at the Shepparton Show in section entered.

HOW TO ENTER-STEP BY STEP

1. Complete your entry form by finding the Section, Class Number and description fitting your exhibit.
2. Deliver or post your entry form with your fees (found at the beginning of the Section) by the date stated. ONLY your ENTRY FORM not your exhibit is required at this time.

3. You will receive your exhibit tickets in your self-addressed stamped envelope, or call in at the office seven (7) days prior to the Show.

Tickets are to be placed on your exhibit either with a small safety pin, or stuck on.

4. THURSDAY - the day before the Show take your exhibit/s with their exhibit tickets on them - and deliver to the CRAFT INDUSTRIES PAVILION in the showgrounds before 10.30am. (or by the time stated in schedule). Enter via Gate 2, Thompson St Shepparton.

For Cookery - place your exhibits in or on whatever is convenient. They will be put on white paper plates at the pavilion. No responsibility is accepted for containers/cases etc., left at the Showgrounds when your article is delivered.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Fruit cake competitions follows the show-group-state level of competition.
2. An Exhibitor having won at Show, will bake another cake for entry in the Group Final; the winner will then be required to bake a further cake for the State Final.
3. Exhibitors are to follow the recipe and specifications as listed below.
4. An Exhibitor having won at show/field day level is not eligible to enter any other show/field day until after the Group judging, when, if not the winning, can compete further.
5. An Exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Group In State Final.
6. Each cake entered must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.
7. If for any reason a winner is unable to compete at Group or State final level, then the second placegetter is eligible to compete.

Hot Tips for exhibitors

- A well-kept competition cake making secret: lay a tea towel over the cake rack before turning the cake out to prevent the imprint of the cake rack appearing on your competition cake.

VAS LTD RICH FRUIT CAKE RECIPE

Open to fruit cake enthusiasts everywhere

Ingredients:

250g sultanas, 250g chopped raisins, 250g currants, 125g chopped mixed peel, 90g chopped red glace cherries,
90g chopped blanched almonds, 1/3 cup sherry or brandy, 250g plain flour, 60g self-raising flour, 1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg, 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger, 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves, 250g butter, 250g soft brown Sugar, 1/2 teaspoon lemon essence OR finely grated lemon rind, 1/2 teaspoon almond essence,
1/2 teaspoon vanilla essence, 4 large eggs.

Method:

Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the sherry or brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight
Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, and then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon
Place the mixture into a prepared tin 20 cm square, straight sided, square cornered tin and bake in a slow oven for approximately 3½ - 4 hours. Allow the cake to cool in the tin

Hot Tip: To ensure uniformity and depending upon the size, it is suggested the raisins be snipped into 2 or 3 pieces, cherries into 4 or 6 pieces and almonds crosswise into 3 or 4 pieces

VAS LTD JUNIOR BOILED FRUIT CAKE RECIPE

A competition for Junior bakers aged under 18 on the day of the local show/field day

Ingredients: 375g mixed fruit, 3/4 cup brown sugar, 1 teaspoon mixed spice, 1/3 cup water, 125g butter, 1/2 teaspoon bicarbonate soda, 1/2 cup sherry, 2 eggs, lightly beaten, 2 tablespoons marmalade, 1 cup S.R. Flour, 1 cup Plain flour,

1/4 teaspoon salt

Method

Place the mixed fruit, sugar, spice water and butter in a large saucepan and bring to the boil. Simmer gently for 3 minutes, then remove from the stove, add bicarbonate soda and allow to cool. Add the sherry, eggs and marmalade, mixing well. Fold in the sifted dry ingredients then place in a greased and lined 20cm round cake tin. Bake in a moderately slow oven for 1.5 hours or until cooked when tested.

VAS LTD CARROT CAKE RECIPE Open to carrot cake enthusiasts everywhere proudly sponsored by Rocky Lamattina & Sons

INGREDIENTS: 375g Plain flour, 2 tsp Baking powder, 1 1/2 tsp bicarb soda, 2 tsp ground cinnamon, 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg, 1/2 tsp allspice, 2 tsp salt, 345g caster sugar, 375ml vegetable oil, 4 eggs, 3 medium carrots- grated(350g), 220g tin crushed pineapple-drained, 200g pecans-chopped.

Method: Preheat the oven to 180C (160C fan). Grease a 23cm round cake tin and line with baking paper. Sift the dry ingredients together into a bowl. In a separate bowl, beat the eggs and oil, then add to dry ingredients. Mix well then add the carrots, crushed pineapple and pecans. Mix to form a smooth batter and pour into cake tin. Bake for approximately 1 hour 30 minutes to 1 hour 40 minutes or until a bamboo skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean. Remove from the oven and allow to cool for 10 minutes in the tin on a wire rack. Upright and allow to cool on the wire rack.
Do not ice.

VAS CARROT AND DATE MUFFINS RECIPE Open to Junior bakers under 18 on the day of their local Show. Proudly sponsored by **Rocky Lamattina & Sons**.

Ingredients: 2 1/2 cups SR flour, 1 tsp ground cinnamon, 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg, 1 cup brown sugar (firmly packed), 1/3 cup chopped pitted dates, 1 cup coarsely grated carrot, 1 tblsp orange marmalade, 1 cup canola oil, 2 eggs-lightly beaten, 3/4 cup orange juice, 1 cup reduced fat milk.
Method: Preheat oven to 190C (moderately hot)-Line a 12 hole muffin pan with Round Paper Muffin Cases. Classic white Muffin Case (35mm Height x 90mm Wide x 50mm Base). Sift dry ingredients into a large bowl, stir in dates, carrots. Then add the combined marmalade, oil, eggs, juice and milk. Mix until just combined. Spoon mixture evenly into Muffin Paper cases in muffin pan. Cook for 20 minutes. To test if muffins are cooked, insert cake skewer: if it comes out clean the muffins are ready.

Stand Muffins in pan for 5 minutes before removing to cool.

REGULATIONS OF THE SHEPPARTON AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY INC to be held on FRIDAY 11th (Day and Night) and SATURDAY 12th OCTOBER 2019. The Shepparton Showground has been declared an ALCOHOL FREE ZONE. No alcohol will be permitted on grounds,

\$200 fine will apply.

Exhibitors are particularly requested to READ REGULATIONS CAREFULLY. -They will be STRICTLY ADHERED TO.

N.B: Entries of exhibits are only received subject to the following regulations:

RIGHT OF ENTRY AND FEES

1. All general entries must be made in writing, on forms supplied by the Society, and signed by or on behalf of the exhibitor, and delivered to the Secretary at her office, Showgrounds High St Shepparton, on or before the specified closing dates. The time for closing the entries will be strictly adhered to. NO LATE ENTRIES. POST ENTRIES EXCEPTED.

2. The holder of a Member's Ticket (with one Guest's Ticket) \$50 will be allowed free admission to grounds. No cars will be admitted to the Showgrounds except with special exemption from rule obtained from the Registrar or those showing an Exhibitors's car pass.

N.B: All exhibits must be the bona-fide property and in possession of the exhibitor at the date of closing of entry.

3. All exhibits must be entered in the name of the owner, who, on making the entry, will receive a ticket with the section, class and number thereon.

4. The Shepparton Agricultural Society Inc reserves the right to refuse any entry.

5. All persons who, after entering exhibits (especially of stock) shall be unable, through some unforeseen circumstances, to exhibit same, will be expected to give notice to the Secretary of their inability to exhibit before Friday 10th September. Post entries excepted.

6. All exhibits must be in the showgrounds, and placed ready for judging at time and date shown at head of each section.

7. No person shall show the same exhibit or part of exhibit in more than one class, except in classes marked "SPECIAL" and if eligible.

This does not apply to dogs or horses.

8. No exhibit competing will be allowed to wear any ribbon, badge or mark until it has been finally judged. Only awards granted at the present show of the Shepparton Agricultural Society may be worn or attached to any exhibit on the Showgrounds. Any exhibitor offending is under penalty of \$10 for each offence.

9. All debts to the Society must be finalised by the date otherwise entries and or ground space may be refused at future exhibitions.

10. No exhibitor will be allowed in that section of the yard in which his exhibit is placed during the adjudication, unless with the consent of the Stewards of the class in which his exhibit is entered, and it shall be the duty of the Stewards to prevent any persons

interfering with the judges, and, if necessary, order the removal of such offenders from the yard, and the prize (if any) awarded to such person may be forfeited.

11. Deleted.

12. All exhibitors shall permit the Stewards to affix their prize cards notifying the awards of the judges, and shall permit same to remain affixed during the continuance of the show.

13-(a) Entries to the Show are accepted subject to the rules and regulations and by-laws of the Society and of the Show;

(b) the entrant agrees to be bound by those rules and regulations and by-laws;

25. None but exhibitors and absolutely indispensable attendants on exhibits will be allowed inside the yards on the first day of the show.

26. None but parties having charge of exhibits, and who must present a pass from the Secretary, will be allowed within the yards before the

time of opening the exhibition.
27. No animals, implements, or vehicles except those entering and vehicles bringing exhibits will be allowed in the yards and the latter must

leave the yards immediately after discharging their loads.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

28. The judges may award a second or third prize instead of a first, or withhold a prize altogether, when the exhibit is not considered worthy.

29. No appeal against the opinion of the judge shall be entertained.

30. **CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:** The judge shall award Reserve Champion Ribbons in all horse and cattle classes in which Champion awards are made. The exhibit second in the class to the Champion shall be allowed to compete for the Reserve Champion.

31. When the judge thinks any stock or article worthy of a prize and there is none offered, their awards shall be taken as a recommendation
for the committee's consideration.

PROTESTS

32. All disputes or protests against exhibitors for infringement of these Rules must be made in writing to the Secretary within one hour of the event, and will be dealt with by the Committee of the Society. Fifty dollars (\$50) deposit to accompany each protest, which made forfeited

if the Committee considers the protests frivolous, and their decisions shall in all cases be final. All complaints against exhibitors or exhibits

must be made in writing, signed by the complainant, and handed to the Secretary by 4.00pm on Sunday, the 13th day

of October 2019. Protest Committee: Messrs. D. Tuhon, M. Parker, F. Hocking and L. Ohlin (minimum of three to act).

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SOCIETY

33. THE COMMITTEE WILL GIVE EVERY POSSIBLE FACILITY TO EXHIBITORS, AND EVERY CARE WILL BE

TAKEN OF EXHIBITS, BUT NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE INCURRED BY THE SOCIETY, EITHER IN RESPECT OF ANY EXHIBIT

OR IN RESPECT OF ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE SUSTAINED BY REASON OF AN EXHIBIT.

34. EACH EXHIBIT SHALL HOLD THE SOCIETY AND ITS MEMBERS IDEMNIFIED FROM ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE SUSTAINED BY

OR BY REASONS OF HIS OR HER EXHIBIT. SPECIAL NOTE: The Society is prepared to give liberal
