ENTRIES: Entries close: Friday 29th September, 2023 @ 5pm. Entries must be received by the close of entry date, NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Via email to Emily McGenniss emily.mcgenniss@gmail.com All original entry forms and fees MUST be handed in to the steward for each goat entered during check in time. Animals without forms submitted and fees paid on the day will not be eligible to show.

ENTRY FEES: one \$30 stud/exhibitor fee, plus \$6 per entry per class. NO REFUNDS ALLOWED Studs with emailed entries will still be responsible to pay outstanding entry fees if not attending show.

SHOW GROUND EXHIBITOR ENTRY FEES: Exhibitor entry fee \$10 pp. Non-exhibitors gate charge on the day \$25, Earlybird discounts online at Ticketebo ends Thursday 12th 2023.

ELIGIBILITY: This show is open to Australian Miniature, Nuwby, Pygmy and Nigerian Dwarf Goats holding current and up-to-date registration with the MGBA. Pygmy/Nigerian Dwarf exhibits must be registered with DNA. Exhibitors must produce a copy of registration certificate/s on the day with a signed copy of their show entry form to be eligible to participate in Breed Classes. All animals must comply with CAE and Johnes testing as detailed in following bio-security section. Animals must be owned or leased by the competitor, who must hold current membership with the MGBA. MGBA rules and regulations apply to goats at ALL shows. Competitor participation in events is at the MGBA discretion and on submitting their entries, all exhibitors are agreeing to the MGBA show rules and code of sportsmanship. Those not abiding by MGBA rules will be removed from the show and any wins forfeited. It is the competitor's responsibility to follow all DPI and governing bodies' state rules and requirements for tick/disease as well as movement of goats between states and to and from MGBA shows.

BREED: Animals are only eligible to enter in one breed type section classes - this MUST be the breed type listed on their registration certificate. For DNA verified Import breeds - please ensure that the breed percentage is indicated on the entry form.

CHECK IN TIME: 9.00-10.00am All vehicles must be parked by 9.30am

JUDGING: Commences at conclusion of the Dairy Show (Not before 11am). DEPARTURE: NOT BEFORE 4PM

ANIMAL HEALTH & BIOSECURITY:

- (i) Animals must be serviceably sound, in good condition and well groomed. Transport vehicles must be clean and meet biosecurity requirements.
- (ii) Sick goats are not permitted on grounds.
- (iii) Any animal found to be carrying ticks or lice and all animals that belong to the same exhibitor must be removed from the grounds.
- (iv) All goats must be free of signs of foot rot.
- (v) A "National Goat Health Declaration" must be completed and accompany entry forms.

A minimum Assurance Rating of 2 (RD1 status) in part A will require evidence of whole herd negative test results (animals over 12 months of age) within the preceding 6 months of any show or event.

A minimum assurance rating of 3 and above in part A are required to be Check Tested (in part B) - all animals exhibited that are over 12 months must have tested⁽¹⁾ clear for CAE and Johne's disease in the past 12 months or be in a CAE and/or JD accredited herd⁽²⁾ (including WA – no longer a JD free state). A minimum total assurance rating of 4 is required to be eligible for participation.

- All animals exhibited under 12 months that are not tested require test results from both tested parents (unless parent/s are import donor/s).
- JD vaccinated goats require testing via fecal culture only.
- Copies of the test results are to be submitted at time of entry, and a copy attached to the relevant signed goat health declaration (all exhibitors).

(vi) Signing of your entry form indicates that you and any person participating with you, declare that your animal/s meet the JD/CAE negative check tested/accredited⁽²⁾ requirements and declare that they have not been in contact with or in the proximity⁽³⁾ of untested or infected animals⁽⁴⁾ nor in contact with the uncleaned and non-disinfected facilities, vehicles or equipment used by any non-accredited herds or untested / infected animals or contaminated land in the

preceding 12 months⁽⁵⁾. Any milk used to feed kids must come from accredited herds or be pasteurized or spray dried.

(vii) Separation of studs / exhibitor groups to prevent movement of faeces or contaminated food, water or bedding and preventing animal to animal contact using a 2m distance between pens or a solid partition (e.g.: tidy grey tarp, boards, specifically made vinyl panel sheet etc. that will prevent contact). Exhibitors are solely responsible for providing adequate supervision of animals at the venue. Restrict animals to designated areas by tethering or penning when not being led. Animals must not be subject to unsupervised handling or access by the general public.

- (viii) Food and water containers to be minimum 30cm off the ground.
- (ix) Prompt removal of fecal material regularly removed to no access plastic lined bins. This is particularly important in laneways and judging areas. Equipment must be cleaned regularly and stored at or in the bin (each stud responsible to clean up after themselves).
- (x) Milk must be suitably caught, contained and removed from grounds and procedures on animals are not permitted at shows or other MGBA events (workshops excluded).
- (xi) the exhibitor is solely responsible to ensure they meet and manage requirements of biosecurity and their accreditation scheme/s (where applicable) when attending MGBA shows or events. The Australian Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program for Goats (Goat MAP) SHOW, SALE & EXHIBITION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE "Provided by Agricultural Shows Australia as part of the National JD Program" form can be obtained from relevant website and used for each venue as a check sheet by exhibitors or their representative(s). (xii) Exhibitors are responsible for completing relevant transport documentation (e.g.: waybill) as required by state livestock authorities.

(1)check tested negative to JD and CAE of 50 goats (or all goats in smaller herd) over the age of 12 months - within the last 12 months; or kids up to 12 months - require parent test results; or all animals on RD1/RD2 property check tested negative within the last 6 mths; or all animals born on an accredited studs are covered by accreditation and only require testing in the next required test that is set by the relevant rules of the scheme. Studs that run other animals (4) or where a boundary breach occurs must have those animals (4) tested too (pooled fecal acceptable). A copy of laboratory test results with animal's names/tags or if not available, a copy of the

laboratory test results with a letter from the vet with the goat's names/tags/identification methods and where applicable a copy of the relevant accreditation certificate to be provided to the stewards on request. Any laboratory test result that shows a positive or inconclusive result must be further investigated by a veterinarian and this positive/inconclusive report must have attached to it the final report of such investigation e.g. A negative facal test for JD or subsequent negative blood test for CAE OR 2 negative faecal tests to clear a positive JD test (or as per MAP). (2) animals from accredited herds are to follow scheme requirements. If only accredited for one (CAE or JD) then testing as per (vi) above is required for the non-accredited (CAE or JD) herd. (3) exhibits are not permitted to make contact with untested/non-accredited animals-unloading/loading; walkways; pens; yards; feed/water receptacles; equipment; transport; show ring; etc at any time, or testing is void. Contact is defined as being within 2m unless separated by a solid barrier. (4) animals: goats; sheep; deer; cattle; camel; bison; llama; alpaca. (5) goats that have been in contact with untested/infected animals (4), their manure or unpasteurised goat's milk from non-accredited sources must be held in isolation and be blood tested. Wice at an interval of 6-12 months or as per an approved property disease management plan. For clarity any exhibitors attending non MGBA shows where untested animals are allowed to enter will be classed as having been in contact with untested animals(5).

EXHIBITS: MGBA Rules and Regulations apply. Full Show Rules are a supplement to this schedule and can be found on the MGBA website www.mgba.com.au MGBA Inc Breed Standards, Heights and Regulations will govern breed related issues IN ALL CASES. All Animals must be measured in prior to the commencement of judging and are to be brought up to the measuring station as directed by the steward. Animals not measured will not be permitted to show. Animals must have NLIS ear tag in place and Identification must be confirmed prior to commencement of judging. (Any goats entering under dairy exemption must still have their ear tags present at the show). Animals should be good breed examples and must NOT have horns or scurs over 5cm. It is desirable that goats have been vaccinated. Exhibitors and handlers are to conduct themselves in an exemplary manor at all times. Abusive, disruptive or unsportsmanlike behavior will result in the exhibitor/handler being excused from the ring, forfeiture of fees/prizes/awards & disqualification from competing in further classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide adequate food and fresh water for their animals for the duration of the show. It is condition of entry that the Best of Breed and Best In Show exhibits stand to be photographed, at the show under the direction of the steward, for recording & promotion of show results. Failure to do so will result in disqualification of exhibit, award/s being permanently removed & forfeiture of entry fees. Photos & results of classes / animals will be published as the Show Society / MGBAA require. Any photos taken at the show may be used by the MGBAA in future promotions.

INSURANCE: All exhibitors/participants are responsible for arranging their own public liability insurance and other insurances. This Association or any of its representatives will not under any circumstances hold itself/themselves liable for any accident, loss or damage and it shall be a condition of entry/participation that each exhibitor/participant shall hold MGBAA and anyone associated with the organisation/conduct of event, blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising through any accident, loss, non-delivery or damage whatsoever.


