SECTION is the Major heading i.e. Cookery, Needlework, etc which is given a number and under which you will find the various categories.

CLASS is the number under the Section which describes your exhibit.

COMPLETE BOTH SIDES OF YOUR ENTRY FORM (one of which is returned to you with your exhibit tickets).

EXHIBIT NUMBER on exhibit ticket is the number given to your exhibit for Judging (names are not used).

NOVICE is a person who hasn't won a first prize at the Shepparton Show in section entered.

HOW-TO-ENTER STEP BY STEP

1. Complete your entry form by finding the Section, Class Number and description fitting your exhibit.
2. Deliver or post your entry form with your fees (found at the beginning of the Section) by the date stated. ONLY your ENTRY FORM is required at this time.
3. You will receive your exhibit tickets in your self-addressed envelope, or call at the office seven (7) days prior to the show. Tickets are to be placed on exhibit either with a small safety pin, or stuck on.
4. Judging Days- Please check schedule for Judging Days. Take your exhibit/s with their exhibit tickets on them, and deliver to the Craft Pavilion in the showgrounds before 10.30am (or by time stated in schedule).
5. **Collection of exhibits and prize money** from Secretary's office Sunday 15th October from 9.00am-12.00pm (cars permitted on grounds). Prize money will be paid out at the office during this time and will be available during Office hours up until Friday 20th October 2023.
6. Do not send cash in the mail. Entries not accepted.

Rules & Regulations - Rural Ambassador Award

- Open to ambassadors aged between 20 and 30 years as of the 1st May 2024 and the finalist must reside in Victoria.
- Each Show can run a Rural Ambassador Show qualifier and the winner at Show Level then represents the Show at the Group Final.
- An ambassador having won at their local Show Level is not eligible to enter any other Show or represent another group.
- A maximum of 12 finalists will be eligible for the State Final with preference to all Group Final winners and each runner up of each group will be considered. If numbers exceed 12 finalist's interviews will be held at the information day to determine the remaining State Finalists.
- The State Final is held at the Melbourne Royal Show and each finalist is judged based on the criteria below.
- Each Finalist will need to supply a resume with a cover letter and a draft/copy of speech for the State Final, which will be given to the judges of the State Final.
- Each Finalist will be interviewed by a panel of three judges and the State Finalist will need to present at speech at the presentation luncheon. The winner will be announced at the presentation luncheon.



Judging Criteria

- **Local Show Involvement (25 Points)** – Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and a desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their Local Show Society.
- **Community Involvement (20 Points)** - Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and a desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their Local Community.
- **General and Rural Knowledge (20 Points)** – Entrants must demonstrate a broad general knowledge and an awareness of Local/National Community issues. Entrant must also have an understanding of current affairs relating to rural life and industry.
- **Personality & Communication Skills (20 Points)** – Personality Traits consistent with both the awards and the entrant's ambitions and goals will be assessed (e.g. enthusiasm, creativity, confidence, leadership). Also, entrants are expected to demonstrate effective communication skills – written, oral and interpersonal.
- **Ambitions/Goals/Interests (15 Points)** - Each Entrants ambitions and goals will be assessed on their integrity and relevance to the award. Entrants must demonstrate steps towards achieving their goal.
- **Style, Grooming & Presentation (10 Points)** – Entrants presentation will be assessed according to the suitability of their attire and conduct in a range of contexts.
- **Conduct (10 Points)** – How the entrant behaves and demonstrates appropriate behaviour in each setting eg. being polite, well dressed and soft spoken.
- **Public Presentation (3-minute speech) (20 Points)** – Entrants public presentation will be assessed according to the quality of the content, delivery and the extent to which it addresses the set topic.

- Open to ambassadors aged between 16 and 19 years on the day of their Local Show.
- Each Show can run a Junior Show Ambassador Show qualifier and the winner at Show Level then represents the Show at the Group Final.
- An ambassador having won at their Local Show Level is not eligible to enter any other Show or represent another group.
- The winner of the Group Final then represents the Group at the State Final, which is held at the annual VAS Convention.
- Each Finalist will be judged based on the criteria below.
- At the State Final the Finalists will need to provide a cover letter and resume that will be given to the judges.
- Each Finalist will be interviewed by a panel of three judges and the winner will be announced at the Convention Dinner.

Judging Criteria

- **Local Show Involvement (15 Points)** – Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and a desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their Local Show Society.
- **Community Involvement (10 Points)** - Entrants must demonstrate an active involvement and a desire to be involved in the future and improvement of their Local Community.
- **General and Rural Knowledge (15 Points)** – Entrants must demonstrate a broad general knowledge and an awareness of Local/National Community issues. Entrant must also have an understanding of current affairs relating to rural life and industry.
- **Personality and Confidence (10 Points)** – Personality Traits consistent with both the awards and the entrant's ambitions and goals will be assessed (e.g. enthusiasm, creativity, confidence, leadership).

Cast on 35 stitches, work 20 rows (MALES) 40 rows (FEMALES) in K2, P2
Rib.

To shape sleeves-Cast 14 stitches at beginning of next two rows at the
same time change to K2, P2 Rib. Rib 24 more rows.

To shape neck-Next row- Rib 21, cast off 21 stitches, Rib 21. Next row-Rib
21, cast on 35 stitches, Rib 21.

Work 24 rows, K2,P2. Cast off 14 stitches at the beginning of next 2 rows.
work 50 rows in stitching stitch then work 18 rows K2 P2 Rib. Cast off.

Sew up side seams to finish.

VAS LTD Rich Fruit Cake: Ingredients - Preferred 100% Australian grown Produce. 250g Sultanas, 250g Chopped Raisins, 250g Currants, 125g Chopped Mixed Peel, 90g Chopped Red Cherries, 90g Chopped Blanched almonds, 1/3 Cup Sherry or Brandy, 250g Plain flour, 60g Self Raising Flour, 1/4 teaspoon Grated Nutmeg, 1/2 Teaspoon Ground Ginger, 1/2 teaspoon Ground Cloves, 250g Butter, 250g soft Brown Sugar, 1/2 teaspoon Lemon Essence OR finely grated Lemon Rind, 1/2 teaspoon Almond Essence, 1/2 Teaspoon Vanilla Essence, 4 Large Eggs.

Method: Mix together all the fruits and nuts and sprinkle with the Sherry or Brandy. Cover and leave for at least 1 hour, but preferably overnight.

Sift together the flours and spices. Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, and then alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Mix thoroughly. The mixture should be stiff enough to support a wooden spoon.

375g mixed fruit, 3/4 cup brown sugar, 1 teaspoon mixed spice, 1/3 cup water, 125g butter, 1/2 teaspoon bicarbonate soda, 1/2 cup sherry, 2 eggs, lightly beaten, 2 tablespoons marmalade, 1 cup S.R. Flour, 1 cup Plain flour, 1/4 teaspoon salt.

Method:

Place the mixed fruit, sugar, spice water and butter in a large saucepan and bring to the boil. Simmer gently for 3 minutes, then remove from the stove, add bicarbonate soda and allow to cool. Add the sherry, eggs and marmalade, mixing well.

Fold in the sifted dry ingredients then place in a greased and lined 20cm round cake tin. Bake in a moderately slow oven for 1.5 hours or until cooked when tested.

1 cup canola oil, 2 eggs-lightly beaten, 3/4 cup orange juice, 1 cup reduced fat milk.

Method: Preheat oven to 190C(moderately hot)-Line a 12 hole muffin pan with Round Paper Muffin Cases. Classic white Muffin Case (35mm Height x 90mm Wide x 50mm Base). Sift dry ingredients into a large bowl, stir in dates, carrots. Then add the combined marmalade, oil, eggs, juice and milk. Mix until just combined. Spoon mixture evenly into Muffin Paper cases in muffin pan.
