- Show Hunters are not eligible to compete in open ridden classes.
- Once a ridden horse or rider has won a Champion in a ring he/she are not eligible to compete in height or age class in another ring.
- Height certificates must be produced if requested.
- Pony club riders are welcome to participate in the open rings in their pony club uniform – please note EA rules require rider classes' under 18 years to present in open rings in short boots

RIDDEN CLASSES: Horses can be competed in all three (3) ridden classes (Open Gender, Novice, Foundation) if they match all criteria. Horses may not be accepted into Foundation classes after the open classes at the Judge/SPPHAV Committee's discretion if they believe a horse has shown adequate canter ability.

NOVICE CLASSES: means not to have won 5 first ribbons or championship sashes in any Standardbred ring in a class of the same description prior to this show. (Led and Ridden counted separately)

This show is part of the Annual HRV High Point Award program and other Annual Awards on offer to SPPHAV members.

Alabar Hero Series

Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided. All horses to be registered with Harness Racing Australia to be eligible. Riders to be 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another qualifier in that calendar year. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar HERO Series Final to be held at VAS Saddle Horse Championships. Class to be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration – Standardbred qualities – conformation – manners, paces and performance – racing related injuries and or blemishes are permitted. The judge's decision is final.

1. By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:
 - 1.1 participation in **(the Event)** is a recreational service for the purpose of section 22 of the **Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012** and also a recreational activity for the purposes of section 32N of the **Fair Trading Act 1999**
 - 1.2 participation in the Event involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.3 participation in the Event requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the Event;
 - 1.4 if the Event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - 1.5 I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the Event;
 - 1.6 I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event; and
