Exhibits must be T.B, Brucellosis, Johnes Disease and Notifiable Disease Free. Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL) Declared EBL Reactors cannot be exhibited.

Department of Agriculture PIC NUMBER of property on which cattle are at present depastured, must be included on entry form. Failure to include the tail tag number will result in entry being rejected by the Society. All animals carry NLIS Tags, scanning conducted upon arrival.

The following practices are strictly prohibited:

- (A) The use of glue or any type of adhesive etc. excepting for the setting of hair and teat sealing.
- (B) An operation or any kind of surgery materially altering the structure or the natural conformation of any part of the animal's body.
- (C) The infusion or injection of any drugs or any other substance or the insertion of any object into the teat, blood vessels, muscles, under the skin or otherwise, of any animal to restrict the flow of milk or alter its natural physical attributes.
- (D) The setting of teats of an animal with any form of glue or other setting substance or any action which alters the natural teat placement of an animal.

Evidence of such practices renders an exhibit liable to instant disqualification and the Exhibitor or his agent liable to a suspension ranging from 5 years to lifetime.

Procedures for the testing of prohibited substances will include "random" tests of exhibits. Should a positive test for a prohibited substance or practice result any costs associated with the testing be borne by the Exhibitor.

Any animal infected with ringworm or warts shall be ineligible for exhibition. Evidence of possible hormone use renders an exhibit liable to instant disqualification. All cattle are to be led by competent handlers and wearing covered shoes.

State Final Dairy Cattle Parading Rules & Regulations

- 1. Parader competitions are conducted under the ASA regulations.
- 2. Competitors must be 15 years and under 25 years of age on the 1st May in the year of the State Final and must reside within Victoria.
- 3. First & Second Placegetters are eligible to compete in the State Final.

Show Level Dairy Cattle Parading Rules & Regulations

- 1. Age of parader must be 8 years & over as of the day of the Show.
- 2. Parader must be attired in suitable clothing including solid shoes or boots.

- 3. The parader must lead a heifer under 2 years as of the day of the Show only.
- 4. Paraders animal must be eligible for breed registration with their respective breed society or entered in an ordinary class with details of exhibit on the respective Show/Event entry form for insurance purposes.
- 5. The judge may ask the parader to swap animals if required.
- 6. Adult or steward assistance is acceptable for a parader under 12 years. (Preferred that parents or siblings are not the assistance)
- 7. Competitions can be split into several age groups depending on the number of entries and level of experience.
- 8. Parader competitions are conducted under the VAS & ASA regulations.

Dairy Cattle Judging Rules & Regulations

- 2. Judging competitions are conducted under the ASA & VAS Ltd regulations.
- 3. Competitors must be 15 years and under 25 years of age on the 1st May in the year of the State Final and must reside within Victoria.
